

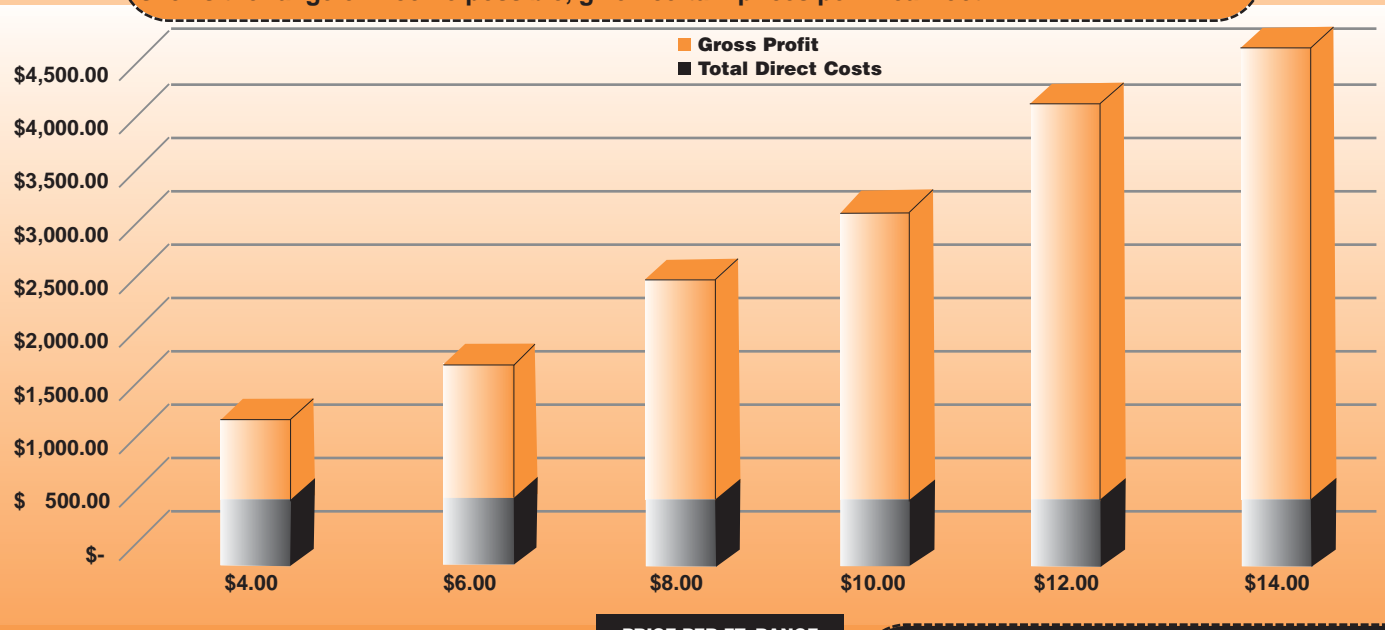
TYGAR's Income Potential Chart & Information

Ranges based on a standard 6x4 decorative and colored curb

Using the hypothetical average cost and price per foot below, this chart illustrates the ranges of Income and Gross Profit possible in a day's work*.
